

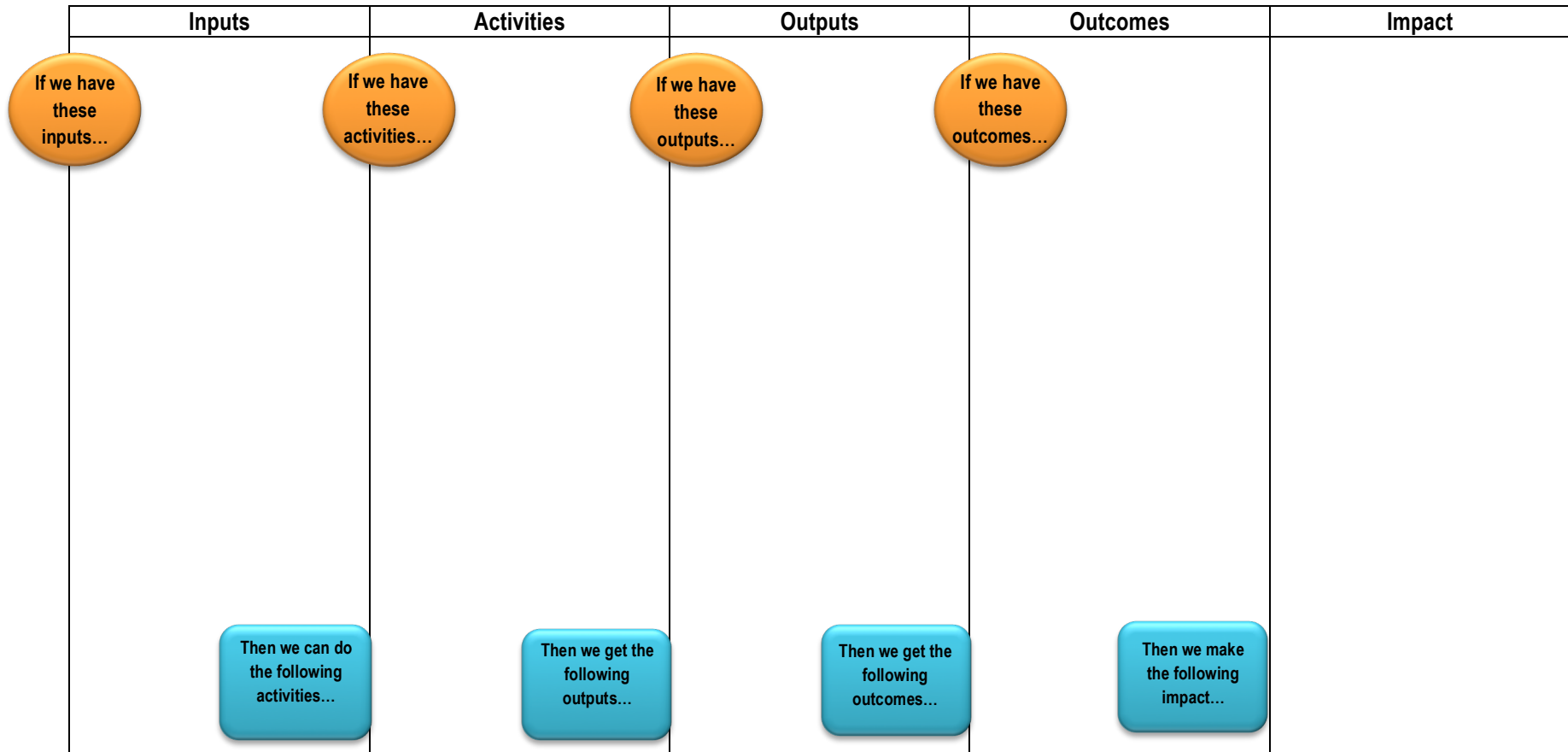

Problem Statement: Findings from local service providers in Oakland, CA indicate that previously HIV un-diagnosed Transgender women of color in West Oakland neighborhoods express being unable to prioritize being linked to HIV care services.
